Did you ever wonder which way to turn the Motor Aid heat control knob? Download, print, cut, paste and wonder no longer.


## **INSTRUCTIONS**

With a small regular screwdriver, loosen the screw that holds the knob. Print and cut the label (see next page). The label should print about 55mm or 2.17" across the outside points of the barbs. You may have to adjust your print size to result the correct label size.

If necessary, add a white line to mark the center of the knob. The label can be indexed in two ways, and may need to be adjusted for your Rialta.

1. Index the label with the white line between the red and blue arrows. (See opening photo.)

2. Index the label with the white line at maximum hot or cold. (See photo below.)
