

Lock Knob Mod

Give your front door lock knobs a bright visual cue for locked/unlocked.

APPROX. MODIFICATION TIME: 1.25 hours

PARTS LIST: All prices are approximate, pre-tax, and pre-shipping.

[1] masking tape	\$.25
[2] Krylon "Fusion" paint (full can about \$4)	\$.25
APPROX. TOTAL COST OF PARTS	~\$.50

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Before removing the lock knobs from your front doors, push the buttons down into the lock position, roll the window down, and put a ring of masking tape around each one as close as possible to the door window sill.
- Then unscrew and remove both lock knobs.

- Put additional tape all the way to the top making sure that there were no voids in the tape.
- Paint the lower portions of the lock knobs using Krylon "Fusion" paint; this paint is made to adhere to plastic.



- When dry, reinstall.
